

## Fishing Contest Rules

- This year vehicles will be allowed on the ice during the fishing contest.** Feel free to bring your ATV/ Snowmobile. Parking on the ice will be at your own risk and we encourage people to use the parking lot that will be provided.
  
- All contestants must be wearing a current Winter Frolic button in plain view.
- This contest is based on weight. In the event of a tie, fish are based on length, if still tied, the first fish registered wins the tie.
  
- First Place: Largest Northern, Second Place: Largest Pan Fish, Third Place: Largest Other Fish, Kid's Division: Largest Perch.
- The contest area includes the entire lake.
- Each angler may use two lines.
- The use of electronics is allowed (depth finders, underwater camera, etc.).
- Snowmobiles and ATVs are allowed on the ice during the contest. parking your vehicle is permitted during the contest at your own risk.
- No pre-fishing the lake 2 hours prior to the official start.
- You may select your spot and drill holes 1 hour prior to official start.
- All contestants will start from the registration area at the official start time. (Shotgun start.)
- All fish registered must be alive.
- Handicapped parking on the lake by permit only.
- All participants will follow Minnesota DNR guidelines for license requirements and fishing methods.
- Youth division is for 12 years and younger. Youth must purchase an adult ticket to be eligible for adult prizes.
- You are encouraged to drill your own holes or borrow a neighbor's drill. If this is not possible, holes will be drilled for you after the start of the contest.
- No coolers will be allowed in the contest area.

Please remember, this is a fun family event - let's be respectful and keep the lake clean by packing up your trash and taking it with you when you leave.
